Oasis tunes a little bit up, it's weird. If I'm playing normal I don't worry about it, but if I'm playing with the CD, I work on tuning my G string as I play the above riff to get the sound right. Don't automatically assume it's up to a G#, I think the sound is lower than that. In between...

Then this riff kicks in, with the following chords being played over it (makes for a decent lead part):
